REQUEST FOR BIDS AND SPECIFICATION

PAVEMENT MARKING

MIAMI VALLEY COMMUNICATIONS COUNCIL

ITEMS REQUESTED

Miami Valley Communications Council (MVCC) is seeking bids from qualified contractors to paint pavement markings (center lines, cross walks, etc) in several of its member cities. The specifications that follow are intended to describe the work required and minimum standards for materials and application. The contractor is to supply all materials, equipment and labor necessary to complete the specified work.

THE CONTEXT

MVCC is a council of governments with eight members and fifteen affiliate members. In this instance we are acting to assist those members who have elected to participate in a cooperative bid for pavement marking services. MVCC is coordinating and overseeing the process on behalf of its members, each of whom will review the bid results and decide individually which offer is the lowest and best bid for that city, and whether and to whom to make an award. Each individual city will do its own scheduling of work and inspection and will pay the contractor directly. Those cities participating in this bid solicitation include:

Oakwood Springboro West Carrollton Centerville Germantown Miamisburg

[Note: In past years there have been misunderstandings and problems arising from this process. The bidder who provides the lowest overall cost quotation may not be the lowest bidder for each individual city - depending upon the particular mix of services each city requires. A bidder whose total cost is not lowest, may in fact be low on some of the unit costs and therefore low for one or more cities. Each city reserves the right to make the bid award that best serves their interests.]

ATTACHMENTS/INCLUSIONS BY REFERENCE

There are several items which are hereby included in this specification, either attached or by reference. Those listed as "forms for all bidders" must be completely and properly executed and included with the bid.

BID DUE DATE/TIMEFRAME

The first advertisement soliciting bids for this work should appear on Friday April 25, 2008. Bids will be received until 3:00 p.m. Friday May 16th 2008 at the offices of Miami Valley Communications Council at 1195 East Alex-Bell Road, Centerville, Ohio 45459; phone 937-438-8887; fax 937-438-8569; URL www.mvcc.net. At that time all bids will be opened in the small conference room on the second floor, read aloud and tabulated. Bidders and other interested parties are invited to attend this public proceeding.

MATERIALS

Materials to be used include white and yellow traffic paint and glass reflective beads. Paints must conform to Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) specification 740.00 for fast drying alkyd paints (white and yellow) as stipulated in the Construction and Material Specification Book. Glass reflective beads must conform to ODOT specification 740.10. Bidders are required to stipulate the brand and specification of the paint and glass beads they intend to use and include a copy of the specification with their bid. All materials used are subject to inspection and approval by each municipal participant's designated representative or liaison person.

APPLICATION

Materials must be applied to dry, clean surfaces under conditions of temperature, humidity and other parameters as stipulated by the material manufacturer. Rates of application shall conform to the specifications of the materials manufacturer and shall be sufficient to remain plainly visible under normal traffic conditions for one calendar year from date of completion.

SCHEDULING WORK

Each city has its own requirements regarding when they want the work done. Two would like the work done in August so school zones will be most visible at the start of the school year. Yet another would like the work done as late as possible in the year so markings are most visible during winter conditions of low light and while ice and snow may be present. Each city will work out with the contractor their preferred time for performance of the work, and will issue its own "notice to proceed" to the contractor.

DIRECTION/LIAISON

It shall be the responsibility of the representative appointed by each municipality to mark or otherwise indicate what kinds of markings are required and where they are to be placed. It is the responsibility of the contractor to contact the municipal representative at the beginning of each day that work is to be done, to go over the scope of that day's work and receive guidance and direction from the municipal representative.

QUALITY/WORKMANSHIP

All paint and glass beads are to be applied at a uniform thickness or rate, with clearly defined edges and no overspray. Rates of application, either in mills of thickness or pounds/gallons per mile shall be as stipulated by the manufacturer to assure acceptable durability of the finished surface. When paint is applied over existing markings, newly applied paint must not be placed more than two inches to one side or the other of the existing markings, and longitudinally must begin and end within six inches of the original markings. Acceptance of any work completed shall be at the sole discretion of the city's representative.

REMOVAL

Improperly placed or unwanted markings must be removed by the contractor, using a method acceptable to the city, at no cost to the city, and replaced as needed.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to regulate traffic flow at the work site and around newly painted areas to: (a) protect the safety of the traveling public; (b) protect the safety of the crew doing the work; and (c) protect newly placed markings from traffic until they are sufficiently dry to bear the passage of vehicles without marring or tracking. In a few instances at very high traffic locations, a city may require that work be done at low traffic times (e.g., early Sunday morning). If there is to be any premium charge for this, the contractor must stipulate under what conditions it will apply and how it is to be calculated.

QUANTITIES

The attached spread sheet shows the types of markings required and approximate quantities of each type, both by individual city and in the aggregate. All quantities are approximate and may be revised up or down, depending upon which cities ultimately participate in this cooperative bid, and last minute adjustments made by each city as their needs evolve and change.

WARRANTY/PERFORMANCE

It is expected that any markings applied by the contractor shall remain in place, clearly visible, and useful for their intended function of directing, regulating and controlling the flow of traffic, for a minimum period of one calendar year from the date of completion. Contractors will be advised of any cases where markings fail to meet this standard and will have a reasonable opportunity to replace defective work before a claim is made against the maintenance bond.

BOND REQUIREMENTS

BID BOND - Each bidder shall submit a bid bond on the provided form, or a certified check, in an amount equal to ten per cent of the total estimated cost of this work, derived by multiplying the proposed unit costs by the estimated quantities provided.

PERFORMANCE BOND - The successful bidder shall provide a performance bond in a form acceptable to the contracting entity, to each participating municipality in an amount equal to 100% of the estimated total cost of work to be performed for that city.

MAINTENANCE BOND - The successful bidder shall provide a maintenance bond in a form acceptable to the contracting entity, to each contracting city in an amount equal to 50% of the estimated contract cost, to remain in effect for one year from the date of completion of the work.

PREVAILING WAGE

As to contracts for this project which for new construction are over \$69,853 (and for re-construction are over \$20,950), every contractor and subcontractor who is subject to Chapter 4115 of the Ohio Revised Code shall comply with that chapter, including but not limited to the payment of prevailing wages as determined by the State of Ohio, the timely submission of certified payroll reports, and the filing of a notarized affidavit affirming compliance with Chapter 4115.

STANDARD CONDITIONS FOR COMPETITIVE BIDDING

1. All bids must be in the possession of Miami Valley Communications Council (MVCC) on or before the time set for opening. Bids received after that time, whether from the bidder direct or through some third party (e.g., FedEx, U. S. Postal Service) will be returned unopened.
2. The outside envelope containing the bid must be clearly marked on its exterior: "SEALED BID".
3. MVCC reserves the right to hold all bids for review for 60 days, unless some different requirement or standard is stipulated in the specification for the particular item/service/contract.
4. It is MVCC's policy, whenever possible, to use open, non-exclusionary specifications, to promote competition, and to make the process as accessible to bidders as possible, consistent with protecting its own interests. We may often cite a particular brand or model as the standard. Bidders are welcome to propose alternates or substitutes which will either provide the same performance at lower cost, or better performance at the same cost. Bidders wishing to propose alternates should bid on the item as specified, and offer the alternate or substitute separately, as a footnote. Acceptance of alternates or substitutes shall be at the sole discretion and judgment of MVCC.
5. MVCC intends to award bids on a "best bid" basis. That means that we will consider, in addition to price, such factors as:
 - a. delivery time
 - b. compatibility with existing items already in use
 - c. history of reliability, durability, and suitability for the intended application
 - d. operating costs
 - e. ready, local availability of parts, service and support
 - f. demonstrated past performance in similar situations
 - g. safety, efficiency and convenience afforded the operator.
6. All bidders are required to be at the time of their bid and during the term of any contractual relationship with MVCC, in compliance with all applicable local, state and federal laws. Bidders may be required to provide records or affidavits when such are required for MVCC to comply with laws (e.g., prevailing wage).
7. MVCC is a political subdivision of the State of Ohio and therefore exempt from most state and federal taxes.
8. It is the general policy of MVCC not to require bid bonds or sureties unless the project is financed by a grant from some other level of government which imposes such a requirement, in which case the specification will make such a stipulation. Performance and maintenance bond requirements will be as stipulated in the specification.
9. All prices must include delivery to MVCC or such other location identified in the specifications.
10. MVCC will not accept liability for any acts of the contractor attendant to performance of any contract. By bidding, any contractor agrees to hold MVCC harmless in regard to any claims arising from contractor's acts.
11. Contractors performing work for MVCC under contract are required to maintain worker compensation insurance as required by Ohio law, and comprehensive liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000.00.
