Mental illness has over a \$1.3 billion dollar impact on the workplace every year in this region alone. Diagnosable mental illnesses are present in over 85% of individuals with substance abuse issues. The suicide rate in youth jumped 70% between 2006 and 2016 according to the CDC.

Mental illness is an invisible epidemic that deeply affects our communities, schools, and workplaces. The Center for Local Government is proud to be working with the Lindner Center of HOPE to offer a series of training sessions for local governments on how to best deal with this important issue, both in the community (school employees, first responders, youth engagement), and in the workplace.
