

## **A PRODUCTION TIP FOR 2023**

When talking into a microphone isn't exactly like talking without one. You'll sound a lot better if you follow a few simple tips on future productions...

- 1) You need to talk right into a mic for good sound quality, but you don't want to put your lips right on the mic. Too close, and you'll sound like you're right in everyone's ear. Too far, and you'll sound like you're on the other end of a hallway. It's best to talk within 6 to 8 inches from a microphone.
- 2) It's easy to forget yourself, turn your head, and talk toward the person next to you while the mic barely picks you up. If you're holding a free mic, just move the mic along with your head. If you're talking into a fixed microphone, you need to stay a little unnaturally pointed toward the mic.
- 3) Keep your volume steady throughout a production. If someone's actively operating the sound equipment, they can boost your voice a bit more, but only so far before the mic is picking up other sounds too. It's still your job not to mumble.



## PROGRAM PROMOS AND ID'S

Want to get the word out about your shows? Producers who have a weekly or monthly time slot can have a :10, :30 and/or a :60 second promo video(s) to promote your community or educational programs on CATV 991 and educational programs on EATV 21.

This is your chance to let your audience and the community know where and when to tune in. Promos will air throughout the week on CATV or EATV, as well on the channel's message boards.
