STANDING IN THE HALL OF FAME



On Wednesday, January 18th, 2023, the Miami Valley Communications Council recognized five volunteers for their accomplishments in public access television by inducting them into the MVCC Hall of Fame. These individuals were nominated for their years of commitment, talent, and dedication to creating local programming that reflects the interests of their communities.

Brian Kerfoot, producer of programs such as *Runnymede: The Manhattan Project*, *The Alex Martin Show*, *Tommy Tours*, and *The Packard Museum Tour*. Brian was posthumously recognized for 43 years of service.

Bob Daley, in addition to covering city council meetings for over ten years, has been the photographer for Centerville and Washington Township for 25 years. Bob was recognized for 40 years of service.

Tom Karslake is a volunteer for Springboro events such as the *Christmas in Historic Springboro Parade* and the *Springboro Concert Series*, in addition to creating the *Work! Talk About What People Do* podcast. Tom was recognized for 35 years of service.

Ed Huff is a camera operator during MVCC's parade season and has worked on parades for the cities of Centerville, Kettering, and Springboro. Ed was recognized for 25 years of service.

Todd Browne, volunteer and producer for community access shows *Two Guys*, *A Few Movies and Popcorn*, *Geek Speak TV*, *Sci-Fi X Cinema* and *Halloween Spooktacular*. Todd was posthumously recognized for 19 years of service.

MVCC CHANNELS UPGRADE TO HIGH DEFINITION

While MVCC has been creating and streaming all of its programming in HD since 2018, viewers of the MVCC cable channels on Spectrum (Dayton South) will notice a significant quality upgrade to their favorite programs when all four channels switch to high definition (HD) cablecasting on February 22, 2023.

The change applies to GATV 5, GATV 6, EATV 21 and CATV 991, and allows for council meetings, parades, high school sports, community access shows and more to be viewed in their original and intended format.

GATV 5 (covering the cities of Centerville, Germantown, Miamisburg and West Carrollton), **GATV 6** (covering the cities of Kettering, Moraine, Oakwood and Springboro), **EATV 21** (featuring local school programming), and **CATV991** (showing community access television for the Miami Valley).
