

ENGERY SAVINGS FOR MEMBER CITIES AND BEYOND

Most members of MVCC's eight member cities who currently are under AES Electric services about the aggregation program, including the city of Vandalia, Brookville, Clayton, Fairborne Englewood, Trotwood, Union and Easton, are eligible for the new MVCC aggregation program. This electric aggregation program will save residents an average of \$300 a year on their energy bill!

MVCC has teamed up with Energy Harbor, who is a fully integrated retail energy provider and independent power producer capable of generating substantial carbon-free energy.

The fixed price for election you will receive each month of **6.75 cents per kWh**, does not change till renegotiations for a new contract in December 2025. Customers on a special arrangement with the utility such as net-metering, Percentage of Income Payment Plan (*PIPP*), and mercantile customers who have not provided affirmative consent to join are not eligible for the program.you may leave the aggregation program at any time.

Future bills will reflect the Energy Harbor price upon your next available meter read date, which might take up to 30-45 days. If you are not currently receiving electric generation from Energy Harbor, your electric utility will send you a letter confirming your participation.

You will not be charged an early termination or cancellation fee if you choose to leave the program at a later date for any reason. If you opt out or leave the program at a later date you will be returned to your utility's standard service offer and might not be served under the same rates, terms, or conditions that apply to other customers served by the electric utility.


MVCC has a long history of competing and winning Philo Awards, MVCC has received 256 Philos since 1986!

MVCC has 18 programs entered in the event. A quick reminder for local content creators; MVCC pays the fee for one video each from MVCC certified producers. If you missed out this year, consider trying the competition in 2024.
